4. Glasgow Kelvin College VS Scheme

4.1 Discussion

The Executive Director presented the paper which he noted is the final application in the current voluntary severance cycle having received applications from City of Glasgow and Glasgow Clyde colleges. He welcomed the collegiate approach and increase in regional consistency in the offering to staff.

The Executive Director welcomed the level of detailed information provided by the College and the approach taken in working with the GCRB Executive to prepare, and as such recommended to the committee that the scheme be approved. The Vice Principal from Glasgow Kelvin College spoke to the information provided from the college speaking to the financial outlook of the college, engagement with staff and trade unions, discussions through the college board and rationale for making savings. She spoke to the potential impact on learning and teaching, student support and remaining staff, noting that the college has a continuous improvement group who are looking at how the college can work differently to address some of these challenges.

The Committee welcomed the high-quality information provided by the college. They discussed with the Vice Principal matters of learner impact, student retention, financial assumptions and efficiencies.
