# 6. City of Glasgow College Update

**6.1.** City of Glasgow College received £1,336,088 in 2023-24 towards the cost of lifecycle maintenance. This is being used to meet the cost of the NPD unitary charge and to meet maintenance costs not included in the NPD contract.

#### 7. Risk and Compliance Analysis

- **7.1.** One of the key risks facing the Glasgow Region is that "Financial sustainability is jeopardised by a reduction in funding and/or an increase in costs." (Risk 008). The provision of additional capital funding helps to mitigate this risk.
- **7.2.** The capital plans for Glasgow Clyde College, and Glasgow Kelvin College, represent a significant investment in FY 2023-24. The funds provided are essential in reducing the financial risk and providing the appropriate facilities for learning.
